## **Change of Scope Request**

A Change of Scope (COS) is defined as changes made to a grant proposal or an activity after biomerieux has granted its approval.

Biomerieux must be notified AND approve all changes of scope prior to implementation.

Examples of changes requiring approval may include, but are not limited to:

Date, time, and/or venue/location of live/in-person activities .

Launch date and/or expiration date of enduring activities.

**Activity types** 

Addition or deletion of components of an activity.

Accredited provider, educational partner, or number of credits.

Proposed content.

Instructional design, including educational gaps/underlying educational needs, learning objectives, format, and/or assessment methods/outcomes methodology.

Budget and changes to Financial Support, including reallocation of budget, number of supporters, or additional sources of income that impact the original proposal, including an excess of funding.

Please note: All budget and title related changes will require an amendment to the Letter of Agreement.

**Submission:** All COS requests must be submitted via the Grant Funding Portal and must include a completed Change of Scope Request Form and a revised budget (regardless of whether the change of scope impacts the total activity costs).
